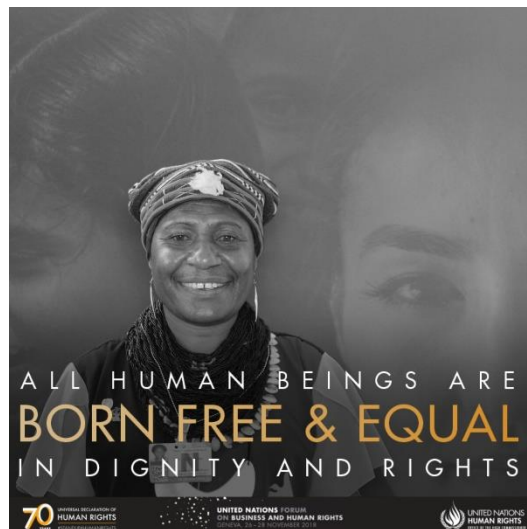
We Don't need BARRICK-PJV;
